

EXHIBITION PARK CLIENT INFORMATION

ACTION TO BE TAKEN IN CASE OF FIRE

Exhibition Park is equipped with a TWO STAGE FIRE ALARM SYSTEM.

Your response to a fire alarm is as follows:

IF THE ALARM SOUNDS AS A "SLOW BELLS" SIGNAL; THIS IS THE ALERT STAGE

- 1) Cease all work.
- 2) Prepare to evacuate.
- 3) Listen to the direction of Exhibition Park staff.

WHEN THE ALARM SOUNDS AS A "FAST BELLS" SIGNAL; THIS IS THE EVACUATION STAGE

- 1) Evacuate IMMEDIATELY using the nearest fire exit and proceed outside to the main parking lot outside of the fenced area. Staff will direct you to the emergency assembly area (see attached diagram).
- 2) Obey all directions from Exhibition Park staff.
- 3) Return only when authorized by Exhibition Park staff.

IF YOU DISCOVER FIRE OR SMOKE

- 1) Activate the nearest fire alarm (pull station).
- 2) Respond to the alarm sounds as shown above.

ACTION TO BE TAKEN IN CASE OF A BOMB THREAT

If a bomb threat is received, notify Exhibition Park staff immediately.
